



He and metalworker Bertil Holmqvist – who constructed trailers for cars – decided to design their own caravan. It would be well-insulated and comfortable, and suitable for use all year round. And so the very first Polar caravan took shape, and was ready for use by Midsummer 1964. Constructed in a barn in Junselevallen, Ångermanland, Sweden. It didn't have a name at that time, but their hobby project attracted a great deal of attention, and all at once they found themselves with a newly established company and factory on their hands. In 1968, production transferred to Dorotea, and Polar has remained there ever since.








Single beds
